- Founded in 2006 by five collaborating nonprofits
- Grown to **54 agencies** with successful histories of serving the behavioral health needs of children and their families
- Agencies meet monthly to advance our mission.

Community Impact: 2015

- CSC agencies directly served **660,000+ children** in 2015.
- Programs include crisis intervention, basic needs, educational and preventive behavioral healthcare, foster and adoptive services, guidance and support for parents, housing, substance abuse prevention and treatment, suicide prevention, support groups, therapy and transitional living.
- 75% of these youth have serious economic needs.
- CSC agencies are committed to serving those who need their help. Hence, they use **sliding fee scales**.
- 1,450+ board members provide guidance and resources.
- 10,200+ dedicated staff empower these agencies, including 5,600+ in StL area.
